### **Overview**

This Guide has been developed under the direction of the EAS Management Committee, to provide supporting information to Appendix 4 of the Electrotechnical Assessment Specification (October 2021), which is valid from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021. The Qualification Guide is to be used by Enterprises, scheme applicants and Certification / Registration Bodies to identify relevant qualifications acceptable to scheme operators, as well as providing guidance for applicants when the required qualifications are not held.

### Introduction

Table 4A defines the application routes for persons who undertake Electrotechnical work, in order to apply to become a Qualified Supervisor. Tables 4B to 4F list the relevant routes for each work category and specify the accepted qualifications.

Successful applicants will be able to demonstrate at Assessment the required combination of technical knowledge, occupational training and practical skills. This is usually achieved through completion of an industry-approved apprenticeship, or, for experienced workers, for example through accredited qualifications using the Experienced Worker Assessment, as well as Recognition of Prior Experiential Learning (RPEL).

It is acceptable to permit new applications from an existing or previously recognised Qualified Supervisor, provided that they have:

- i) been a Qualified Supervisor within two years of the application; and
- ii) can provide a letter or similar evidence from the previous scheme provider confirming their Qualified Supervisor status and the scope of work previously assessed, which must be equal to the scope of work being applied for.

An applicant Qualified Supervisor will need to have at least 2 years' evidence of responsibility for the technical standard of electrotechnical work and evidence of ongoing Continuing Professional Development.

If the applicant's electrotechnical qualifications are not listed in the following tables, please contact the relevant certification or registration body for further guidance. Contact details for the Electrical scheme operators are available <u>here</u>.

## **Qualifications from outside the UK**

When an applicant for a proposed QS has been trained outside the UK they need to demonstrate that they have fully met the same UK qualification standards as if they had been trained in the UK.

The Electrotechnical Skills Partnership (TESP) and ECS have developed a new service with the qualifications recognition body Ecctis (formally known as UK Naric), that will map non-UK electrical qualifications against the specific knowledge requirements of the Experienced Worker Assessment referenced in this Qualifications Guide.

The Electrotechnical Experienced Worker Assessment enables those who trained outside of the UK to demonstrate they meet the requirements of the relevant underpinning core technical competence referred to in Table 4A of this Guide.

In many cases, the applicant's existing qualifications will be recognised. However, in all cases, existing qualifications must be assessed and verified that they meet the same criteria as the UK requirements by taking the Ecctis Electrotechnical Skills Statement.

The service will provide the applicant QS with an 'Industry Skills Statement' – further information can be found here - <u>https://www.ecctis.com/Qualifications/SOCCS/Default.aspx</u>

There will be no exemptions from the practical performance elements – even if the applicant QS has significant practical experience of working overseas, they will still need to be working in the UK to complete the practical elements of the Experienced Worker Assessment. Practical assessments must be completed using work within the UK which can be verified/observed.
